Dear Members,

Congratulations to Sami Kennedy-Sim and Sam Wells for 2nd and 3rd places in World Cup events so far this season. After Tim Easdale's improving performances last year, I was very disappointed to hear that offers for this northern winter did not come to fruition and although we offered sponsorship Tim could not find a program to suit and therefore stayed home. I was also disappointed to hear Jenny Owens could not continue her Alpine skiing campaign due to a lack of on mountain support and injury. – See page 4 for more on our elite skiers.

It was nice to see Rex Cox and Joan Gardner's contribution to skiing recognised in the Perisher Historical Society summer newsletter. The PHS newsletter can be viewed on our website.

I am pleased the Lodge Directors have agreed to complete a portion of the fire upgrade works at Charlotte Pass to ensure we can open this winter. We owe thanks to Joe DiFalco and Tim Moore who have worked with the Fire Consultants, NSW Planning and our builder Tim Jackson.

Sadly, due to failing health, Kurt Bloomfield, has resigned as a Lodge Director after 40-year service. I have worked closely with Kurt at Kahane and like so many others recognise his tremendous contribution not only to Southern Alps but also to the Perisher Ski Patrol. To Kurt – we thank you so very much.

The Kahane Working Bee at the end of February was a was great success; we had a record crew of 38 members; fortunately, Tim Moore was able to use some volunteers to help clean up under and around Southern Alps Lodge at the Pass otherwise we would have been working on top of each other.

Some of the team provided crucial help in the kitchen with the less mobile volunteers - Kurt, Peter Collett and Helen Pearson (recovering from ankle surgery) seated at the staff dining room table peeling & chopping the vegies and fruit salad.

There was time for jobs in between meals; ensuites were scrubbed to near new state, new heater, ventilation fan & lights installed in the drying room + floor repaint, 2 dining room tables re-

finished and numerous other important jobs completed.

On Saturday evening Kurt cut a "thank you" cake with standing ovation from all present. Kurt has been the main driver for Kahane work parties and it was very fitting to have so many members present.

Thank you to all members who volunteered and shared a great weekend. NPWS generously provided entry fee waiver for the work party.

Prior to Christmas Sam came 3rd in the Ladies Aerials World Cup event at Beidahu Lake in China. Following this World Cup event Sam was a member of the Australian trio who also came third in a special teams event for aerial skiers. Since China Sam dealt with a few illnesses and small injuries but still jumped very well during qualification, including a "best ever scoring full-full in the qualification round at Lake Placid" however landing under rotated in World Cup finals at Lake Placid and Deer Valley pushed Sam out of the top ten skiers at both events. Sam suffered a mild concussion at Deer Valley and missed the next event in South Korea. Sam has since placed 5th at Minsk in Belarus and is optimistic for last few world cup events. Sam thanked us for our continued support.

Jenny Owens

Jenny's Alpine season ended early after being selected to race at World Champs she could not find necessary support from other teams on the mountain, leaving her without "help during course inspection, no course report, no video and no coaching at most of the races." Some of these athletes have already submitted trip reports, and the committee is awaiting reports from the rest.

There have been some excellent results.

Junior Bus trip

- 28 June - 1 July, 2017

Children aged 8 to 13 years are invited to apply for our Junior Bus trip. The coach leaves Sydney on Wednesday 28 June evening and returns on Saturday 1 July evening. The trip cost includes return travel to Charlotte Pass by coach & snow cat, accommodation & meals at Southern Alps Lodge, 2-1/2-day lift tickets, ski hire, ski or snowboard lessons with Charlotte Pass Instructors, free skiing with adult supervisors and evening activities.

Our bus trip aim is to improve skiing or snowboarding ability of our young club members, to learn to be responsible and have a great time. Klara Henderson is the bus trip coordinator this year. Contact Klara Henderson on 0411709413 or email: klara.henderson@gmail.com

Applications need to be in before the next Juniors committee meeting on Tues 9 May. If you are interested in being a parent helper come along to the meeting. Applications will be sorted by age with the older children being offered places first. Application forms will only be sent to successful applicants after cut off age has been determined. See the enclosed flier for further details. Please encourage your children to join and take part in this 40+ year tradition within our great club, I can speak from personal experience, that it is a trip of a lifetime for the kids.

The Orientation day for Bus trip attendees, is again at the 12ft Skiff Club on Longueville wharf at the end of Stuart St Longueville on 28 May. (Thanks as always Michael Este and the club). We start at 1 pm with a sausage sizzle and some activities to encourage the bus trippers to mix and meet each other. This is particularly important for the new children to meet the old

hands and the 2017 parent helpers. A short information session will allow any questions on bus trip or race training will be discussed.

Junior Race Training

- 7 - 14 July, 2017

Eight children from the Bus trip will be selected to have a week of supervised, ski and cross country race training at Perisher. The Junior committee will pay for race coaching, lift tickets, race entry and transport to races at Thredbo and Charlotte Pass. Parents will need to pay lodge accommodation and provide transport to and from Perisher, which may be shared with other parents.

All race team members will stay at Kahane Lodge under supervision of the team managers. The team members will be required to train for alpine skiing and cross country skiing. This program is designed to give our Juniors the chance to experience race training before progressing to a race club. Fitness before the bus trip is essential for best results. Children are only allowed to be in this team twice to allow many to experience this training.

Thredbo Junior Interclub

- Tuesday 11 July, 2017

We will be conducting training at Perisher on Monday 10 July preceding the Junior Interclub at Thredbo on Tuesday 11 July. If there are any children who would like to train with a coach, contact the Committee, and come around to Perisher. Juniors, who have attended the training, thought it was a valuable experience to be able to hone their racing skills. We welcome suggestions for encouraging the over 13 to 18yr olds group, who have some race experience to race for SASC in the Junior Interclub. Please come to our meeting on Tuesday 9 May 2017 at Carlingford.

We will need to have SASC competitors entered in all age groups (up to 19 yrs) to have a chance to improve last year's 2nd place. We are fortunate to have a growing number of race club juniors competing for us, but not in all age groups! Race training is not essential and you do not need to be registered for Interschools. The Junior committee will pay race entry and 1 day lift ticket for the children who participate. Day trippers are welcome to join in at Charlotte Pass. Sponsorship for Junior racers

The days are becoming shorter and the temperature is lower so we are on the pathway to our winter fun.

Our annual working bee at Kahane Lodge in late February had around 40 helpers.

Rod and Kurt had an extensive work list ready, covering painting, cleaning, grass cutting and general repairs.

Small work parties travelled to and from Charlotte Pass for a clean out of the loft and dungeon and other general maintenance. We readily filled a 6 cubic metre bin with odd skis and boots, furniture, timber and junk. Tim Jackson, our builder, has kindly volunteered to take the overflow to the tip for us.

The working bee was however tinged with a great deal of sadness with Kurt Bloomfield resigning after 40 years as a Lodge Director due to ill health. Kurt has put body and soul into SASC and we are all very thankful to him for the many ways he has grown and nurtured the SASC family.

At the end of dinner on Saturday night Kurt cut a magnificent cake for us to share and we all toasted Kurt to show our appreciation and great respect.

As usual Uschi and her awesome Team of tireless kitchen helpers provided us with delicious meals and snacks throughout the weekend.

The lease renewal process for Southern Alps Lodge at Charlotte Pass continues. The latest advice we have received from National Parks is that the evaluation of proposals received from the Expression of Interest process is continuing. Proponents have been asked clarification questions that require a response within a specified time.

The time frames as detailed on the website https://engage.environment.nsw.gov.au/perisher-range-and-charlotte-pass-resorts-management-review remain relevant to the process, giving a Market timeline -

Request for tender process - Jan to Jun 2017 and

Implementation of new management arrangements - Oct 2017.

The SASC Directors have no idea, at this stage, when we will be asked to engage with this process and apply for a new lease for our Lodge. We also have no idea whether the change of Premier and Cabinet reshuffle will affect the Management Plan process completion date.

The required fire safety upgrade work at the Pass is in progress. Our builder, Tim Jackson, and his team are on site and making steady progress and we plan to have the lodge 'guest ready' by Easter. We are fixing new fire resistant plasterboard to the ceilings in the ground floor rooms, installing two new fire proof doors at the bottom of the stairwell and blanking off the two windows on the southern wall of the dining room to allow safe travel down the fire stairs.

At Christiania its 'steady as she goes' in the lead up to Easter and the forthcoming winter season. Our Lodge Manager Brigit will be engaging a professional cook/chef to assist her during the winter season. In addition during summer there is now a room cleaning fee of \$20/room for each summer stay and our caretaker will be responsible for cleaning the rooms. This was necessary to ensure that each room is clean and tidy for the incoming guests.

Our Juniors and our Cross Country/ Bushwalking group are ready for another great year of outdoor enjoyment and our Social Team (led by Marie Westgarth) is preparing our End of Season party at Waterview (Homebush) on Saturday October 28th.
