3. If you are having difficulty with operation of Clubman please check the internet browser you are using is displaying Clubman correctly. Using Chrome or Edge is preferred. 4. When making your booking ensure you search "Add Guest" field to find family members, if you cannot find them please contact the secretaries by phone or email. All family members were imported from the old records so if you cannot find them you must contact the secretaries.

5. The "ENROL NEW GUEST" button is only to be used to add Temporary members or non-member Lodge Associates who have not been booked on Clubman previously.

6. Recent Club newsletters can be found on Clubman > More > Files.

7. If you are having difficulty with your member data please contact the secretaries, If you are having booking difficulties please contact one of the booking officers.

Snippets



Harrie "Bruce" Murrell (15/6/1927 - 6/2/2020)

Bruce was born in Mosman and moved to Willoughby in 1931. He was an apprentice with Shell at Gore Bay, qualified as a fitter and turner and later worked at Garden Island Naval Dockyard. He joined Qantas in 1954 and was posted to Cocos Island, then an important link in the Qantas route to London. It was a very happy part of his life and he made many life-long friends. Bruce and his brother, Russell, managed the family real estate business after their father died suddenly in 1957. Bruce was always very committed to anything he tackled. He passed all the real estate institute exams and also became a qualified valuer. He introduced computers into the office very early and by 1989 was using remote access technology. Bruce and Russell sold their real estate business in 1995. Bruce was very active in the community, as a Mason for many years, and with Rotary International, taking up leadership positions including President of the St Leonards Rotary Club. Bruce got his motorcycle licence in the late 1940s which he kept until 2016.

About 1949 he made his first trip to the snow. Skiing became his other great passion and he kept skiing well into his 80's. He skied in Europe and North America.

Bruce was a well loved regular at Kahane Lodge in August with mates Kerry Manhood, Jack Grant and John. His ski tales of the early days were legendary.

Bruce maintained a very active retirement, continuing his work with Rotary and skiing as often as he could and being involved with the local Men's Shed. He told one of his grandsons that skiing "was the next best thing to flying like a bird."

Bruce was a man who enjoyed life to the full. He was genial and sociable, enjoying the company of family and friends. He was also a true and proud Australian gentleman, sadly missed by all who knew him.



Sponsored Skiers Sami Kennedy-Sim -

The Ski Cross tour has taken Sami across Europe, North America, Scandinavia and Russia. Sami has regularly finished World Cup events inside the top 10. Highlights were 2nd place at NorAm Cup with the Canadian team and 10th in Nakiska at the World Cup, her best result at that location to date, and 6th and 7th places at IdreFjall in Sweden.

Sami has also been thinking of home, writing - "Hoping all is well at home during this devastating bush fire season- I have everyone in my thoughts".

Theo Coates -

Theo managed to complete the Sweden leg of his training and made some good technique improvements. Unfortunately Theo had a big crash in December while training GS at Reiteralm (Austria). The talus bone in his left foot was fractured but the ligaments remained intact. Theo returned home on the 23 December to have diagnosis confirmed. Since then he has started rehabilitation but full recovery will take up to 6 months.

Theo has returned to study at University of Wollongong and is hopeful of being back on snow in June. Theo wrote - "Thank you for all your support, it means the world to me".
