#### Clubman Update

The booking system was under extreme load when the Lodge share-holder week and 5-night bookings opened. Much of the load was caused by members submitting multiple booking attempts before the system could process their earlier request.

The processing was improved to queue bookings, in order, for the Club member opening date.

There are concerns, however, that some members are disadvantaged because of their poor internet access or familiarity with the booking process. The Co-operative has formed a small group to look at the issues and work with Clubman to reduce the impact on members.

A few points to note:

- \* if your booking is denied there is a reason displayed in the notes.
- \* if you re-submit the same booking without resolving the reason it will also be denied.
- \* initially Week and 5-night bookings must start on a Sunday.
- \* only one week is allowed in the July school holiday period.
- \* if anyone on your booking has an overdue payment for subscription or booking, your entire booking will be denied.
- \* Clubman availability calendars display number of beds available, not rooms.

Snow Australia, the Olympic Winter Institute of Australia and the media partners are to be commended for their efforts particularly with the added complexity caused by COVID-19 restrictions.

Congratulations to Sami Kennedy-Sim who finished 8th in the Women's Ski Cross event! Sami was rewarded with the honour of carrying the Australian flag at the closing ceremony. Such a proud moment! It was great to see so many members supporting and engaged in Sami's journey. I wish Sami all the best for whatever path lies ahead.

This year, booking demand has been very strong, perhaps due to the 2 years of COVID cancellations, no overseas travel, Winter Olympics, and some shareholder movements creating the perfect booking storm. I feel for members who were not able to get their preferred winter bookings.

The total number of Club members (shareholders and non-shareholders) has only increased marginally in the past 12 months.

Although Sami was not able to race in January due to an injury, she was named to compete in the Women's Ski Cross at Beijing Winter Olympics. Sami finished 11th in the qualifying session, won her 1/8 final and quarter final races to gain a spot in the semi-finals. Sami came in 4th in her semi, forcing her into the small final against three Canadians who forced her into 8th place equalling her position in 2018 at PyeongChang. Sami carried the Australian flag at the closing ceremony recognising her contribution to the team. Sami was due to finish the season with a World Cup event at Sunny Valley in Russia. Due to political tensions, the World Cup teams evacuated to Europe and Sami headed home. Sami wrote to members:-

#### LODGE REPORT

After two Covid 19 affected seasons we sincerely wish that the 2022 winter season can proceed without any issues.

The bookings for the 2022 winter season have been very strong. There was an issue with the Clubman booking system for the first hour of the Lodge members bookings but the issue has been identified and steps taken to endeavour to stop any repeat.

The directors are constantly considering the operation of the booking system and there maybe some minor changes for the next year.

The Covid 19 policy is being constantly reviewed and we ask that all persons attending the lodges comply.

Summer bookings, especially at Christiania, have also been very good and more of our members and guests are taking advantage of the summer months in the mountains. If you are a member of a sporting or other group you might consider arranging a stay at one of lodges for the group. We would like to make our lodges year round venues. Christiania and Kahane presently have managers on site for most of the summer months.
