Sponsored Skiers

We had three sponsored skiers intending to compete in the Northern Hemisphere this year.

Letitia Murphy has returned after a successful Northern Winter program with International Racer.

Initially poor snow affected Letitia's race plans but changes on the run ensured a full program of 7 races some National Junior events and other FIS events in Italy. Letitia aimed to lower her FIS points in GS but ended improving her slalom points. Letitia plans to continue with International Racer in New Zealand during the 2023 southern winter and at Mt Hotham for training and FIS ANC races.

Letitia thanked Southern Alps for our support.

April Wynn had some great training with her coach Hannes Grimmus but unfortunately in mid-January she

crashed in Switzerland. April has not returned to competitive skiing since the mid-January concussion, she is staying with the team and learning from the experience of those around her, the intention is to remain with the team until they return home at the end of March.

Matthew Clayton – After investing so much in preparation for the slopestyle ski training, Matt broke his foot before leaving Australia. Initially it looked like Matt could be out of action for 6 weeks and with that expectation he could still travel early February, however after the first few weeks the recovery time was extended to at least 3 months. Matthew now has a second injury, and his foot is back in a moon boot. He is devastated that these injuries have affected his plans but hopes to be right for air bag training in Jindabyne soon and then events at Thredbo and Perisher over winter

WINTER BOOKINGS

Bookings opened with a rush. Clubman processing times were extended by members entering bookings before the 7 am start time, attempting to book more than one Lodge shareholder's associate, and entering multiple requests for the same dates while their initial request was in the processing queue.

Nordic Week 2022

I am new to skiing and to cross country skiing but. I was lucky enough to be at Nordic week when one of the grand old men of the mountains, Andy Cairns, was at the lodge. Andy took some of us who are new to cross-country skiing under his care and skied with us for a couple of days. He was generous with his time and his knowledge; helping to build our confidence in our skiing and our ability to navigate in the beautiful areas away from the resort.

On our first ski with Andy we skied under bluebird skies from Charlotte's down the valley to Johnnie's Plain and then to the right bank of Spencer's Creek. We crossed the Kosci Rd at Spencer's Creek bridge and skied up Bett's Creek looking for a snowbridge. The recent rain and the spring snowmelt were really starting to bite into the snow and finding a stable snowbridge proved more difficult than we had anticipated. We abandoned the snowbridges to the creek and instead skied Bett's Creek catchment until lunch.

While we were searching for a way across Bett's Creek Andy's eldest son, Murray, his wife Michelle and their daughter Hayley took the opportunity to get in some telemarking practice on a northern outcrop of the Ramshead Range before they headed out to the

Main Range the next day. We returned and regrouped for lunch on the snow grass on the eastern edge of Johnnie's Plain and returned via the valley before heading to the deck of the Stillwell Hotel to round out the day.

Our second ski with Andy was under greyer skies. Once again, we headed up the valley and then turned right towards Wright's creek. We followed the creek all the way up to the head of the waterfall, took some selfies and enioved the solitude.

We had a nice ski back down and headed to the saddle between Sugarloaf and Guthrie. We skied up Spencer's Creek through the trees till we were almost level with the north peak of the Paralyser. We (well, Andy) reckons this was about three quarters of the way between Charlotte's Pass and Illawong lodge. We didn't make it to the new bridge at Illawong as the rain started so we quit while we were still dry, turned and headed back to the lodge.

Nordic week was great fun; you don't have to be a highly skilled skier to enjoy areas away from the resorts. That said, I wouldn't be heading out to the main range unless you knew what you were doing or were with someone who was very experienced in the back country. So, why not strap on a pair of cross -country skiis or snowshoes and get amongst it.
